(at least the ones you should memorize)

Move Around Workspace	.spacebar
Zoom In	.spacebar z
Zoom Out	.spacebar command option
Fit in Window	.command 0 (zero)
100% View	.command 1 (one)
Enlarge View	.command + (plus/equal sign)
Reduce View	.command - (minus/hyphen)
Show/Hide Rulers	.command R
New	.command N
Open	.command O
Close Window	.command W
Save	.command S
Print	.command P
Quit	.command Q
Undo	.command Z
Redo	.command shift Z
Cut	.command X
Copy	.command C
Paste	.command V
Paste in Front	.command F
Paste in Back	.command B
Select All	.command A
Deselect All	.command shift A
Join	.command J
Average + Join	.command option shift J
Make Guide	.command 5
Release Guide	.command option shift + double click*
Make Compound Path	.command 8
Make Mask	.command 7
Show Type Palette	.command T
Preview/Artwork mode	.command Y
Transform Again	.command D
Group	.command G
Constrain Selection/Line/Shape	.shift
Create Selection from center	.option
Add to Selection	.shift
Hide/Show Palettes	.tab
Switch Cursor shape	.caps lock
Convert Point (while drawing with the pen tool)	option
Toggle to Selection tool	.command
Toggle to Selection+ tool	.command option
Duplicate something while dragging it	option

* Once you release a guide, you must either move it and make it back into a guide (command 5), or delete it at once.
